

Members of the Society of Indexers – subscription discount

From 1 March 2017, any member of the Society of Indexers (SI) who joins the SfEP will enjoy a 20 per cent discount on our membership subscriptions. Here is how this works.

If you already belong to the SfEP

Your annual renewal invoice (normally issued in February) will state that you are an 'Entry-Level [or Intermediate, or Professional, or Advanced Professional] Member who belongs to SI', and show the discounted subscription due. We have not yet been able to update the online renewal system so, despite what the invoice says, please telephone the office when you are ready to renew (020 8785 6155) and we will 'do the necessary' over the telephone. In future years you should be able to renew online.

If you decide to join the SfEP after 1 March 2017

To join the Society you must [complete the online application form](#), and the system then collects the subscription (see 'Subscriptions – individual members', available from the SfEP office, for further information) and a joining fee. If you choose to pay by credit card we make a small extra charge for this.

On the application form you will be asked to enter some personal details (page 1), select a grade (page 2 – see below) and pay the subscription and joining fee (page 3). There is a line on page 3 in which you should enter the discount code **179876sajs106**, to tell us that you are a member of the SI and claim your discount.

What grade to join at?

Every individual joining at a grade above Friend is charged the subscription for Entry-Level Membership in their first year (no matter which grade they apply for). If you apply for a grade above Entry-Level Member your grade will be provisional (see 'How provisional membership works', available from the SfEP office, for further information) until our Admissions Panel has assessed your application. Within one month of joining you must [complete the online upgrade form](#) and supply all evidence required to support your application by attaching it to the form.

Before applying to join at a higher level, [please check the requirements](#). Marshalling the evidence can take time: it might be better to join at Entry-Level (you don't have to tell anybody!) and do the following. Members can access the online upgrade form at any time, complete part or all, and then save it to the secure Members' area of our website. Until you decide to submit it, no one other than you will be able to see it, meaning that you can take the time to polish your application.
