

Travel information: Getting to Wyboston Lakes

Conference 2017

By rail

The closest stations to Wyboston Lakes are St Neots and Bedford. Both are a taxi journey from the site (see below for details). St Neots is connected to King's Cross in London by a frequent 40-minute service on the [Great Northern](#) line, and is two stops south of Peterborough, which is on the [East Coast Mainline](#) and other major railway lines from the north and Midlands.

By coach or bus

- **National Express:** There is a coach stop in Market Square, St Neots, with direct services from Birmingham and Milton Keynes. For further information, visit the [National Express](#) website.
- **Local buses:** The X5 bus route runs between Oxford and Cambridge with stops in St Neots and Bedford. Details can be found [here](#).

By local taxi

Local minicabs are available from St Neots and Bedford railway stations. The journey to Wyboston Lakes should cost £8–£10 from St Neots and around £20 from Bedford.

By car

Wyboston Lakes is conveniently located on the A1 between Sandy to the south and St Neots to the north, and at the end of the A428 from Cambridge to the east. Parking

There is ample free parking around the training centre. This can get quite busy during the week, but at weekends is much quieter so plenty of spaces should be available.

By air

Wyboston Lakes is close to both Luton and Stansted airports.

- From **Luton Airport Parkway** station, there is a direct train service to Bedford on [East Midlands Trains](#). Trains are frequent and the journey takes around 30 minutes. For more information visit the [Luton Airport](#) website.
- From **Stansted**, take the Stansted Express to Tottenham Hale, change to the southbound Victoria Line to Finsbury Park, and then take the Great Northern service to St Neots. For more information visit the [Stansted Airport](#) website.
- There are direct trains from **London Gatwick** to Bedford on [Thameslink](#) trains. Journeys take around 2 hours, depending on the number of stops on each service. For more information visit the [Gatwick Airport](#) website.
- From **Heathrow**, you can either take the Piccadilly Line directly but slowly to King's Cross, or the Heathrow Express to Paddington and change to the Hammersmith and City or Circle Line to King's Cross. From King's Cross, take the Great Northern service to St Neots. For more information visit the [Heathrow Airport](#) website.
